(b) The Cross River State Government through the Federal Government of Nigeria has received t credit from the International Development Association (herein referred to as IDA) towards the cost of Agro-Processing, Productivity Enhancement and Livelihood Improvement Support (APPEALS) PROJECT, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to eligible payments under the contract for construction of 13.3km Farm Access Roads in Cross River State.
